Utility Shutoffs

Shutoff valves for our home's utilities

Locations of and instructions for water, power, and gas shutoffs

Evacuation Plan (in case of wildfire)

What to pack if evacuation is anticipated

Go Bags
Extra drinking water
Prescriptions & eyeglasses
Important paperwork
Computer, phone, wallet, keys
Face masks & cleaning supplies
...

Steps to take if evacuation is anticipated

Put above items in car
Park car in driveway facing out
Wear sturdy, protective clothing
Stay tuned to emergency radio
Turn off utilities if instructed
Notify emergency contact
...

What to do if evacuation is ordered

Leave immediately
Follow recommended evacuation routes
Stay tuned to emergency radio

Where to go, and routes to get there

Local hotels, homes of friends or family members

Clean room location, if evacuation is not recommended

Room that can be closed off to outside air

Meeting Places (in case of earthquake)

Block meeting place/Emergency Assembly Point

Out-of-neighborhood meeting place

Local hotels, homes of friends or family members, etc.

Our plan for communicating and reuniting with family members

Text messages, Safe & Well, etc.

Escape Routes from Inside Home (in case of home fire)

Two routes from every room; instructions for second-story exits
